International Graduation Requirement

Undergraduate Programme in Management

To accelerate internationalisation, as of 2016 a compulsory international graduation requirement for undergraduate students in Management was established. This was a central component of the undergraduate programme in Management reform.

Within the framework of the programme reform, and in order to enhance student's international perspective, students must fulfil the following requirements before graduation:

(1) To take and pass two (2) courses delivered in English among those offered at UASM and Uniandes.

AND

- (2) To participate in at least one of the following international experiences:
 - a) Student exchange or double degree
 - b) International Summer School:
 - a. Enrol and pass two courses in the UASM International Summer School or other Uniandes School's Summer School.
 - b. Enrol and pass two courses in other international Summer Schools delivered abroad (Toulouse Summer School, Manheim Summer School, among others.).
 - c. Participate in one of the leadership programmes offered by the School (e.g.: Lehigh University's Global Village).
 - c) Successfully participate and pass an academic minor at Uniandes:
 - a. Minor in Language and Culture
 - b. Successfully complete 5 levels of a language other than English or Spanish.
 - d) International internship abroad approved by the University's Centre for Career Placement.

| | 2.2 UASM International Summer School (Uniandes School of Management) | Students who enrol in any of the School of Management's International Summer School must take and pass at least two courses. These subjects are valid as two programme electives. If they are validated for the international requirement they will not be valid to comply with the two compulsory English courses requirement. | |
| | 2.3 UniAndes Summer School | Students who enrol in any of the University's summer school courses must take and pass at least two courses. It is not compulsory to validate the courses. It is up to the student to decide whether s/he wants to have the courses assessed to be recognised for credit. If they are validated for the international requirement they will not be valid to comply with the two compulsory English courses requirement (if courses where taken in English). | |
| | 2.4 Global Village | Students participating in Lehigh University's Global Village will be considered as having complied with the international requirement. | |
| | 2.5 Babson build: The Entrepreneurship Program for University Students | Students participating in Babson build: Entrepreneurship Program for University Students will be considered as having complied with the international requirement. | |
| | 2.6 Intercollegiate Business Convention (HUWIB-IBC) | Students participating in the Intercollegiate Business Convention will be considered as having complied with the international requirement. | |
